Charging

Emobility Consulting has over 14 years experience in electric mobility and charge infrastructure. The main office is based in The Netherlands and work is done across Europe. Two years ago the owner of Emobility Consulting moved to France. He started Holiday Charging to support campings, hotels, B&Bs and people with a second / holiday home with charging infrastructure, solar panels, energy storage systems and the total management and billing toward the users (electric vehicle drivers). This is offered via a full financed one-stop-shop concept. Energy management and integration of charging infrastructure, solar panels and energy storage are not common yet in France. Holiday Charging is working together with the Dutch company Maxem to facilitate this.

Number of the month

In 2022, the public finance deficit in France stood at 4.7% of GDP, lower than the 5% expected by the government, and down from 6.5% in 2021 and 9% in 2020.

This improvement is mainly due to the strong growth of the French economy over the year (2.6% in volume and 5.7% in value), which triggered an increase in tax revenue thanks to the dynamism of the total salary mass, the rebound in consumption and the increase in production taxes. The end of the support measures put in place during the pandemic also led to a decline in public spending.

Although the figures were slightly better than might have been feared, public finances are still very much in a state of deterioration. Public debt was 111.6% of GDP in 2022, compared to 112.9% in 2021, a level well above the 97.4% in 2019, before covid and the 'whatever it costs'.

France is now amongst the group of European countries with the most worrying public finances evolution. And this is likely to remain so in the coming years, given the economic slowdown (growth is expected to be 0.7% in 2023 and 2024), the rise in interest rates and the tense political context that makes reform difficult. The reactivation of European budgetary rules from 2024 onwards will require the confection of a more restrictive budget this year.
