French GDP expanded by 0.5% in the second quarter, significantly above the 0.1% consensus expectation. This was surprising, given the social unrest in the quarter and rather subdued sentiment indicators.

However, domestic demand still contracted by 0.1% on the back of a 0.4% fall in consumption and a 1.6% decline in residential construction. So, growth was entirely due to external demand. The recovery in the car industry probably boosted exports, though there was also the delivery of a cruise ship, which helped to push up exports of transport equipment by 11.2%.
